The Sagamore Spring Golf Club Learning Center offers professional golf clubfitting with major manufactures like Titleist.

Q: How many other sports have you played where the equipment you used was not fitted to you?

A: Zero, because every sport's equipment you have ever used has been fit to your hands, feet, body, etc. Golf clubs should be the same—**FITTED!**

Q: What is a lie angle?

A: It is the angle between the centerline of the hosel/shaft and the ground. It is the primary influence of both direction and trajectory of a golf shot.

True or False: When a golfer addresses their ball, the club should lay flat on the ground.

False. During a golf swing, a shaft bows downward due to centrifugal force and forward due to head velocity. Because of this, the club's toe should be off the ground at address. This angle is determined during a clubfitting session.



Sagamore Learning Center Teaching Philosophy

- #1—Interview the student
- #2—Student warms up on the practice range
- #3—Evaluate 3 pre-swing fundamentals:
Grip, Stance, and Posture
- #4—Observe student hitting golf balls:
Paying attention to ball flight
- #5—Individual instruction then is tailored to students 2 or 3 swing needs
- #6—Drills, swing training aids, and/or demonstrations used to simulate student's new swing
- #7—Lesson summary, on paper, with hand written drills for student to practice on their own
